Experiential Learning - Role Play

It provides students with real-world scenarios, allowing them to learn skills applicable to situations such as negotiation, debate, teamwork, cooperation, and persuasion.

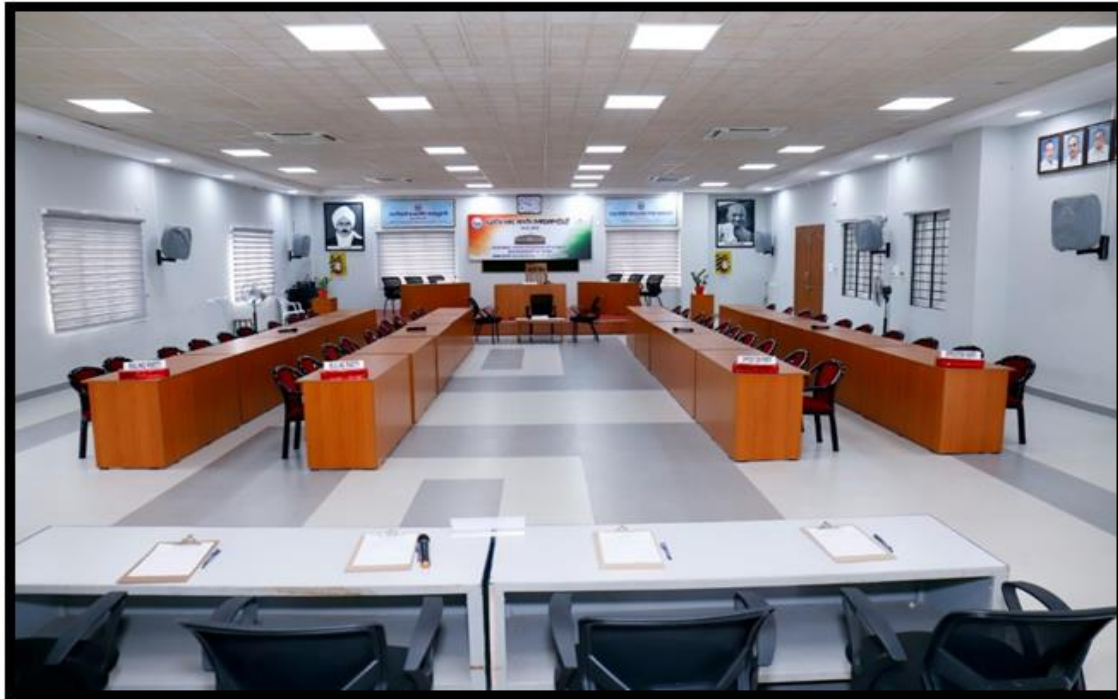

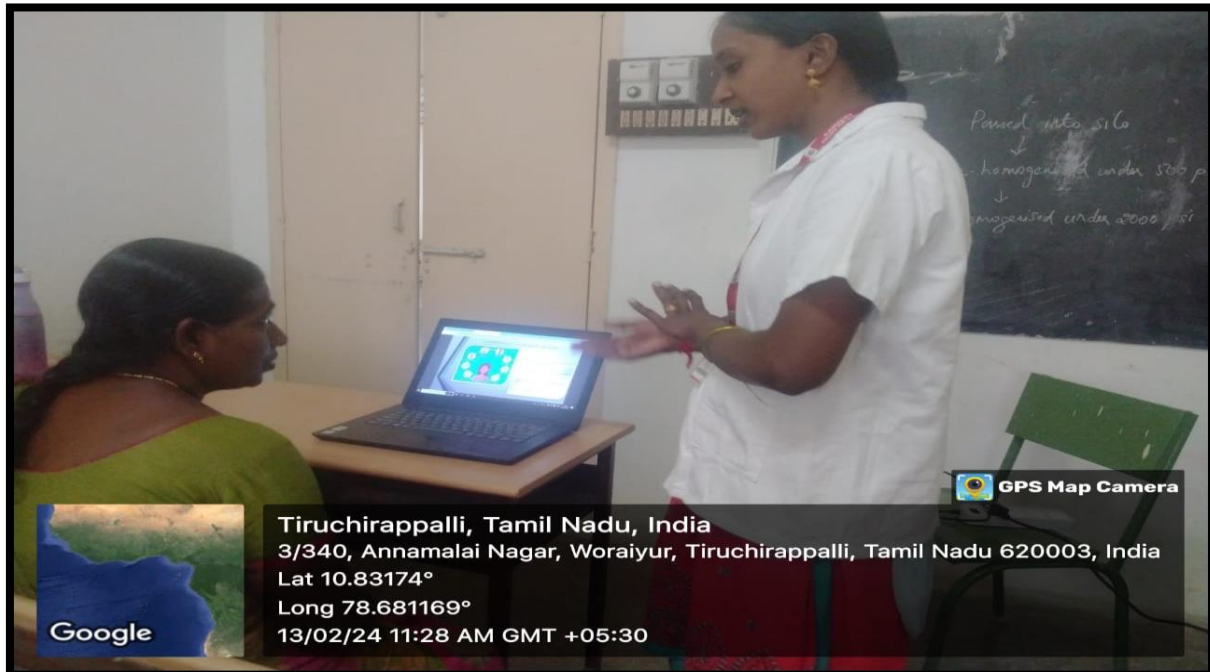

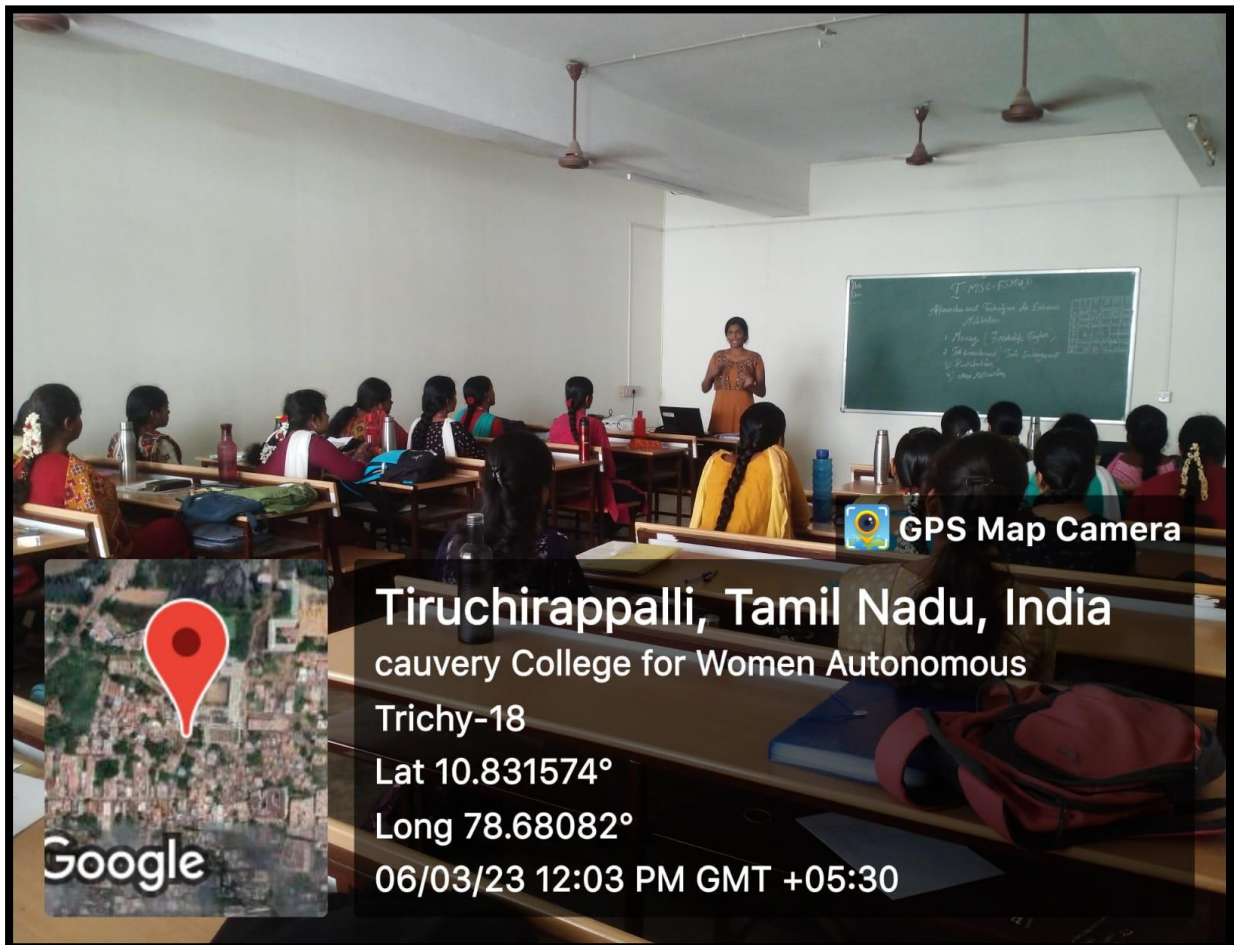
