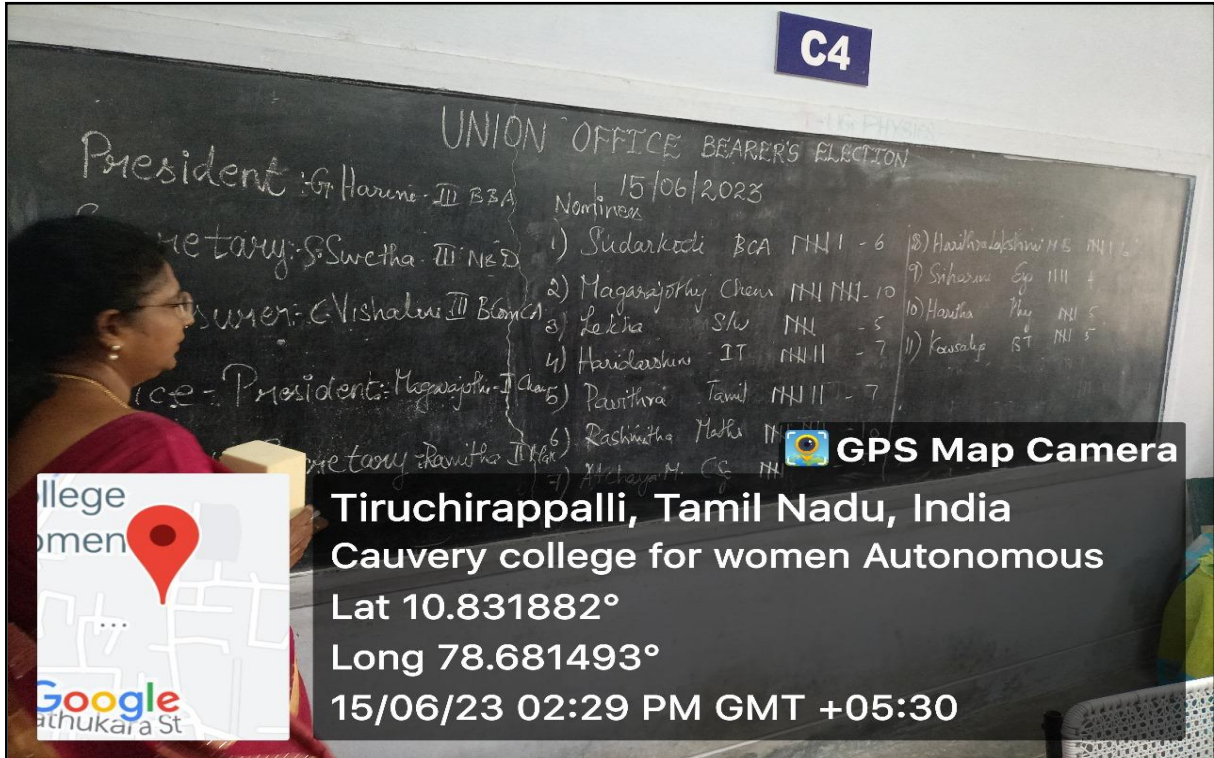
Cauvery Students Union Election 15.06.2023

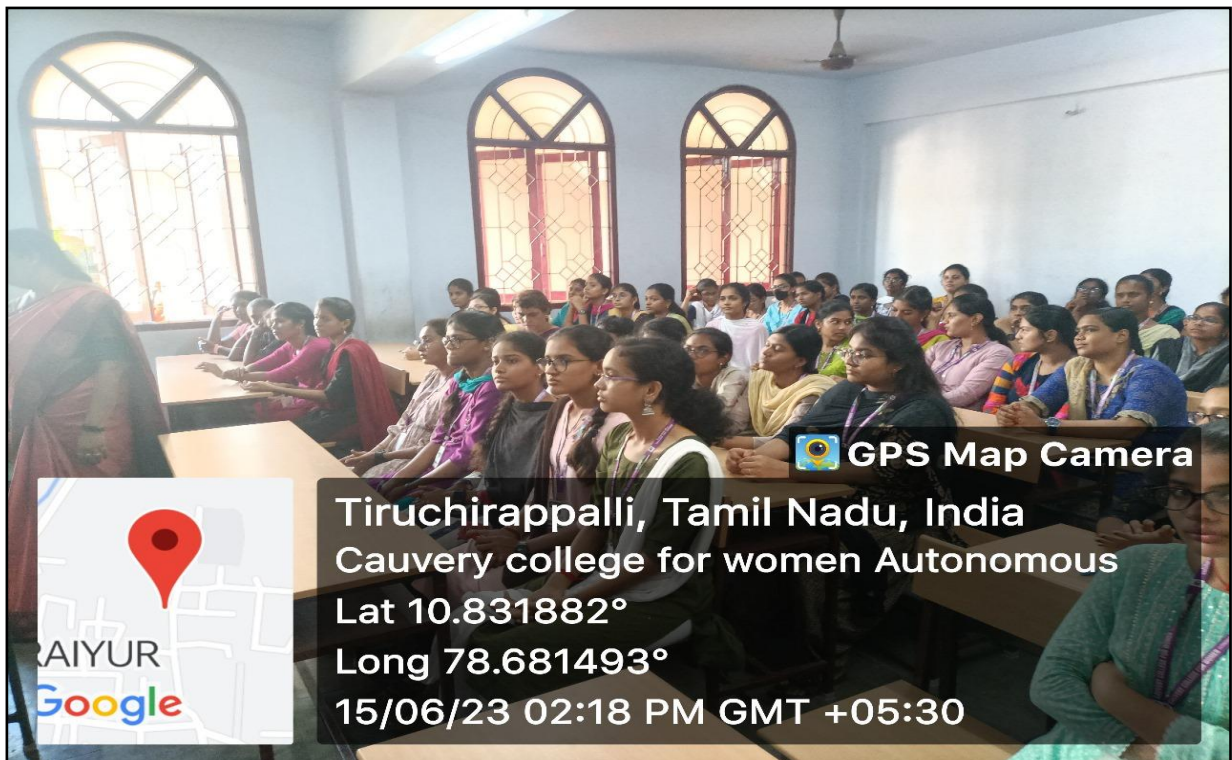

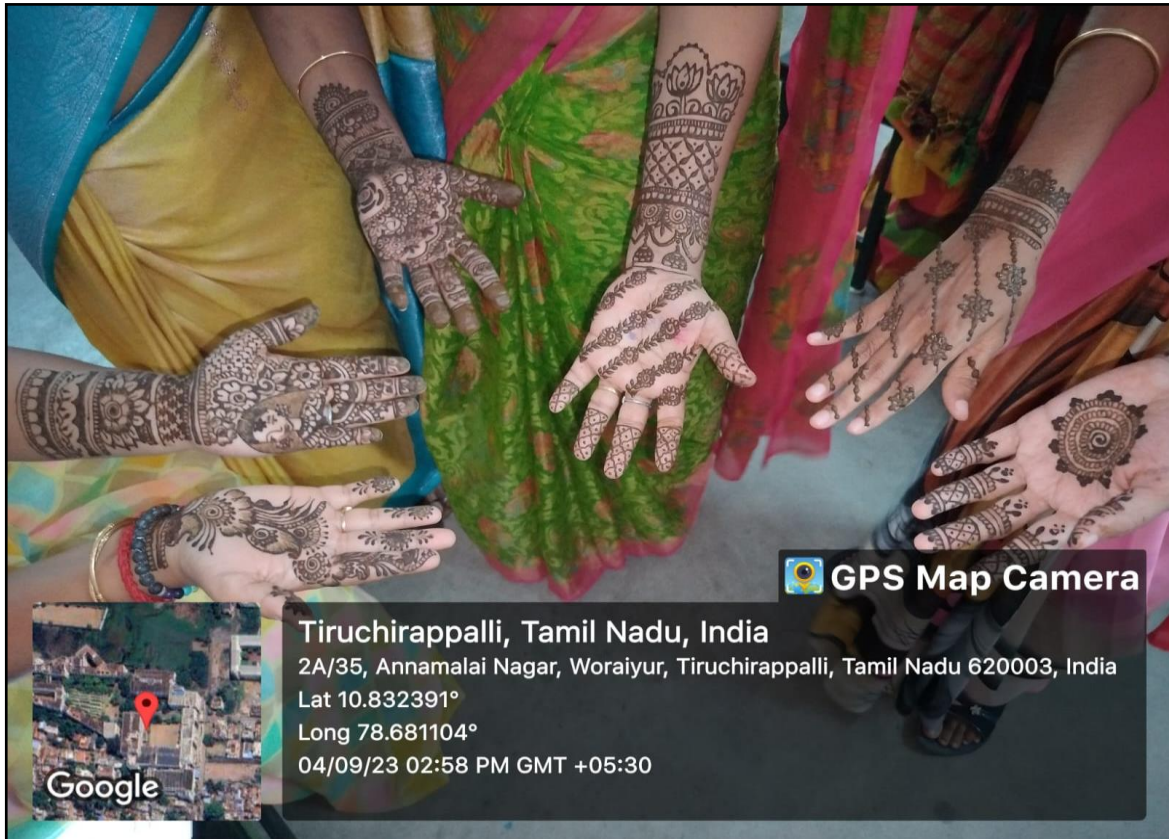



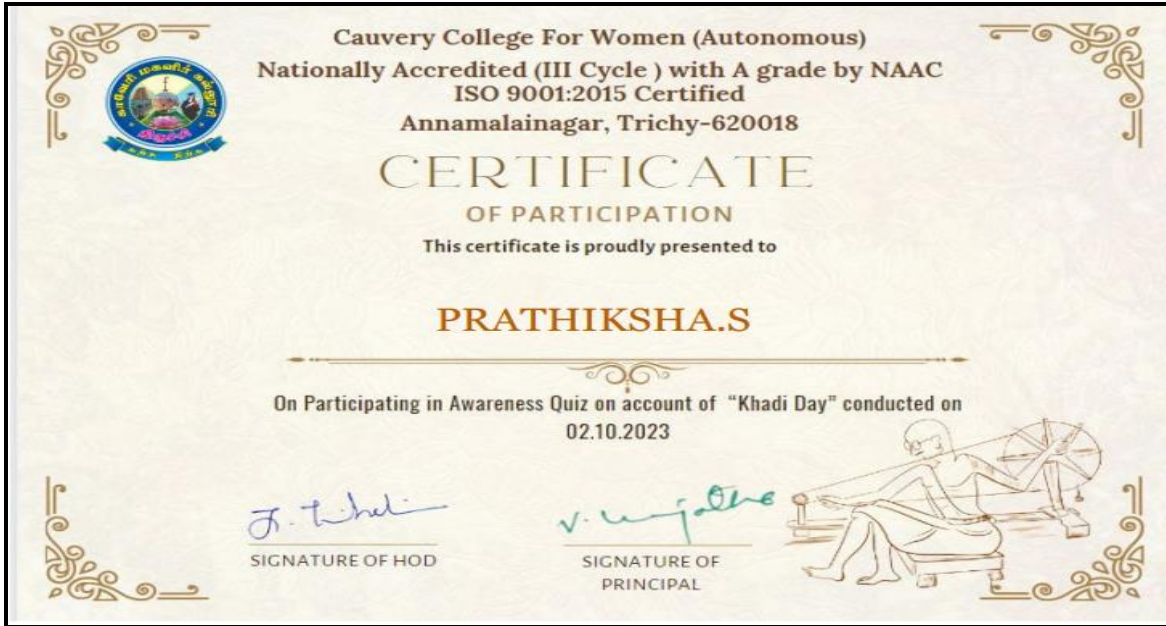

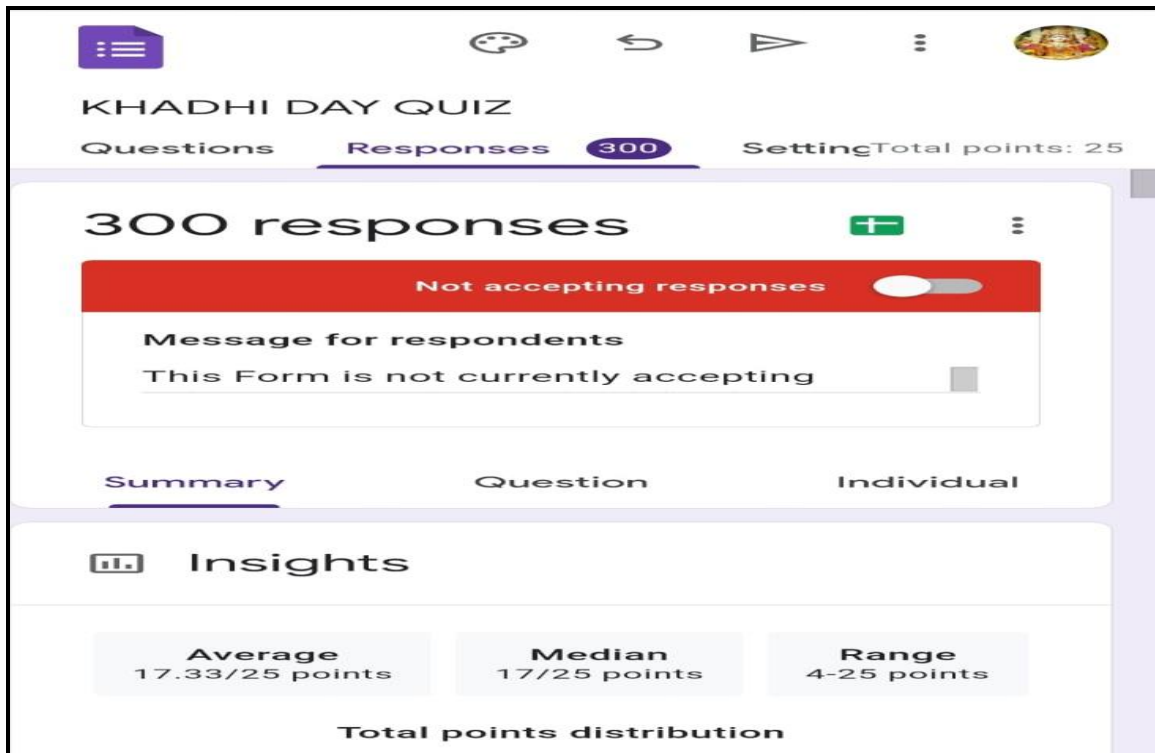

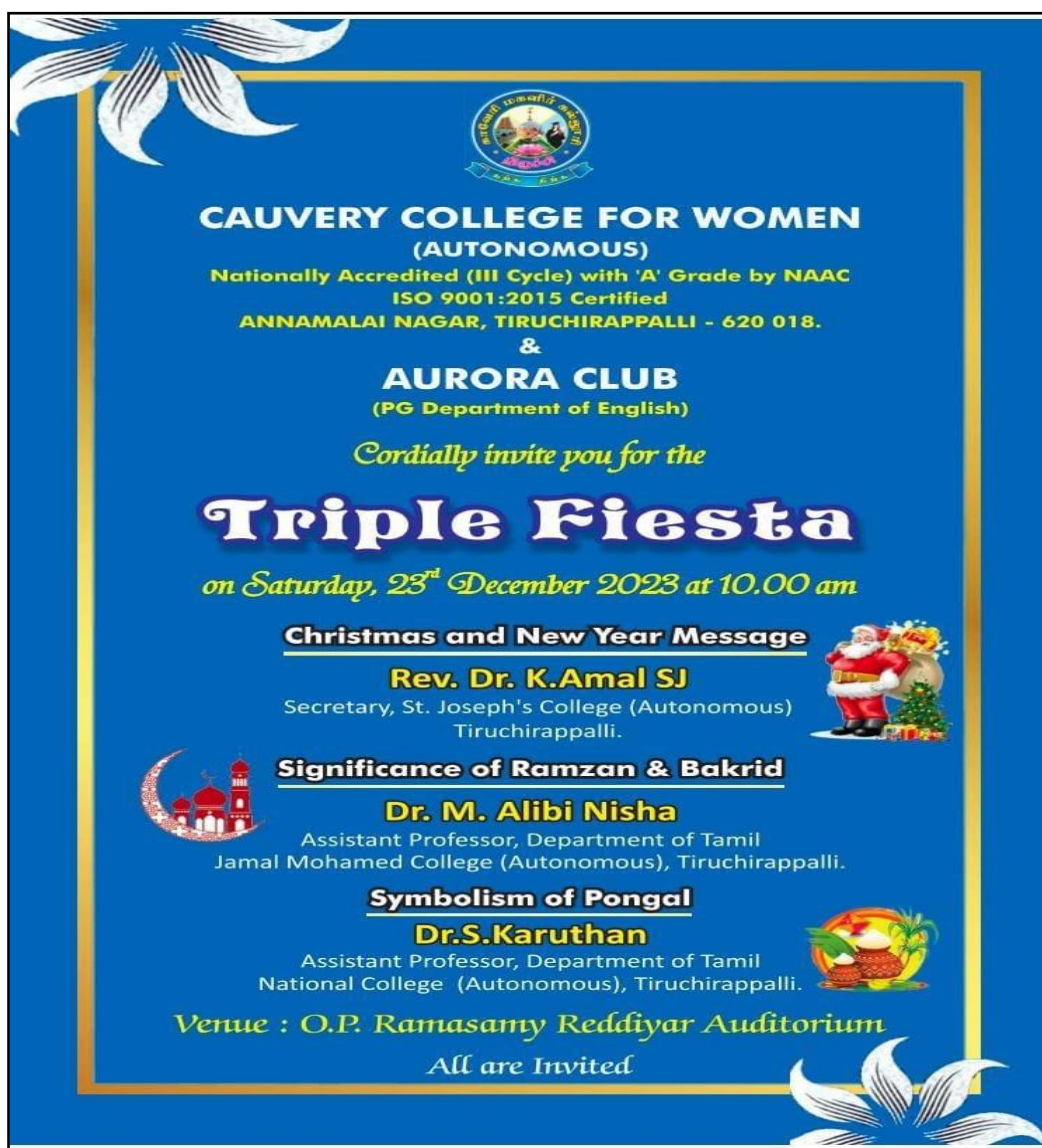

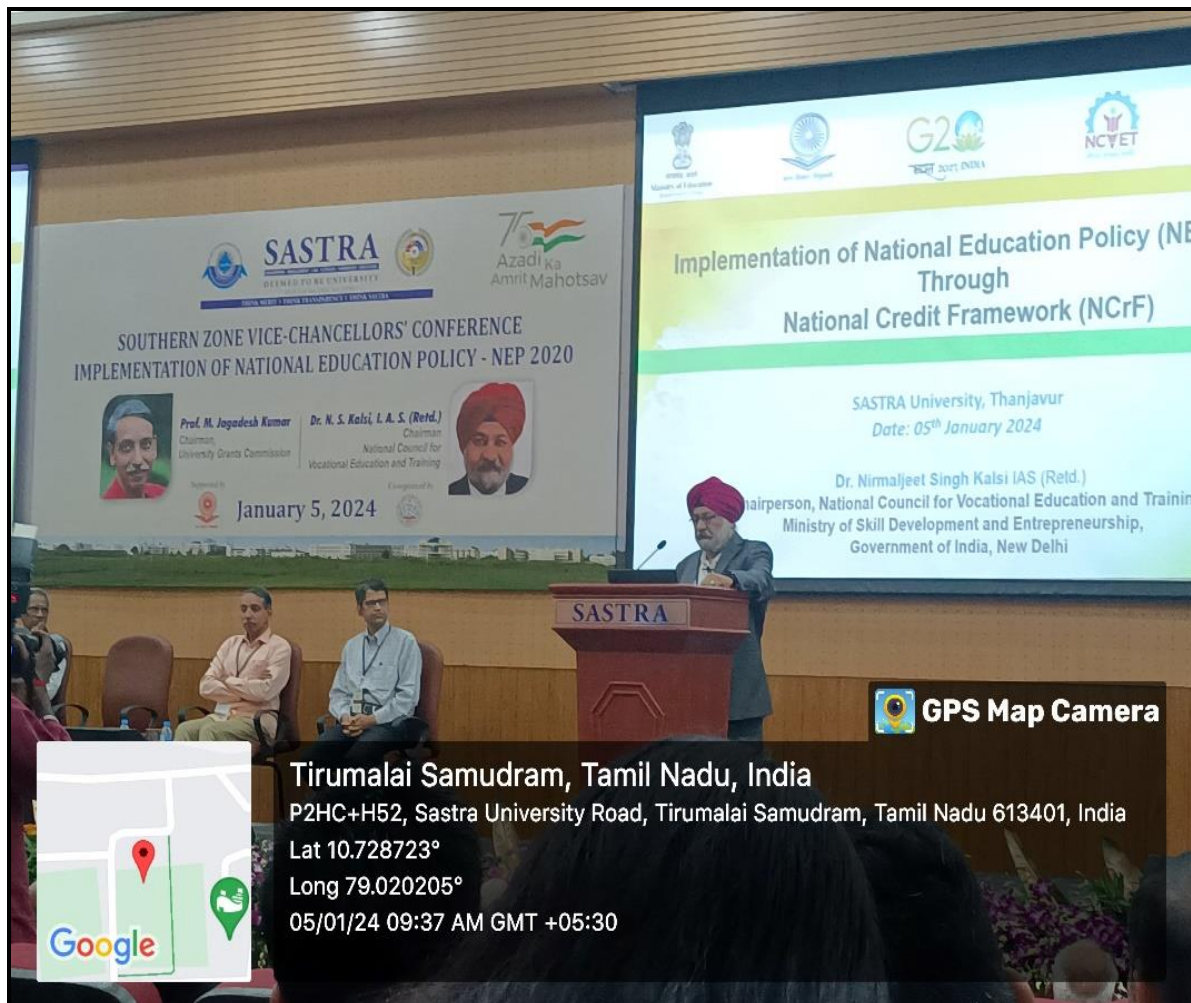

UGC chief hails TN's focus on skill-based education

'NEP Will Facilitate Access To High Quality Education'

Thanjavur: Tamil Nadu is doing very well in terms of higher education and has been focussing more on skill-based education for students, University Grants Commission (UGC) chairman M Jagadesh Kumar has said. He was speaking to reporters here on Friday after inaugurating the southern zone vice-chancellors' conference on implementation of National Education Policy 2020 at Sastra University.

"For a long time, Tamil Nadu has been focusing on providing skill-based education to students. Tamil Nadu is the leading state in the country and contributes enormously to the growth of GDP. This is what we would like to do in the rest of the country also. So, NEP 2020 is providing us the road map to make sure that every student who wants to study

has access to high quality education," he said. Tamil Nadu has great universities such as Anna and Madras Universities and central institutions like IIT-Madras. The state is industrially advanced because of the human resources available here. At various domains Tamil Nadu is progressing at a rapid rate, he added.

Kumar however said that one cannot be complacent about what we have achieved so far. "There is a greater need to

ensure that high quality education is made available to students coming from all backgrounds, especially those coming from rural background. Because education has become very competitive," he said. Kumar said we need to focus on achieving excellence so that our educational institutions find a place among the top global universities. "We need to constantly work to improve the quality of education," the UGC chairman said.

To a question about participation in CUET for central universities, Kumar said the highest number of candidates writing the exam among the five southern states were from Kerala and Tamil Nadu. "The student composition in the central universities is becoming very diverse. CUET provides a level-playing ground for all students across the country," he said. Asked about autonomy for colleges, he said UGC wishes to provide as much freedom as possible to colleges in terms of designing their own curriculum, examination system and re

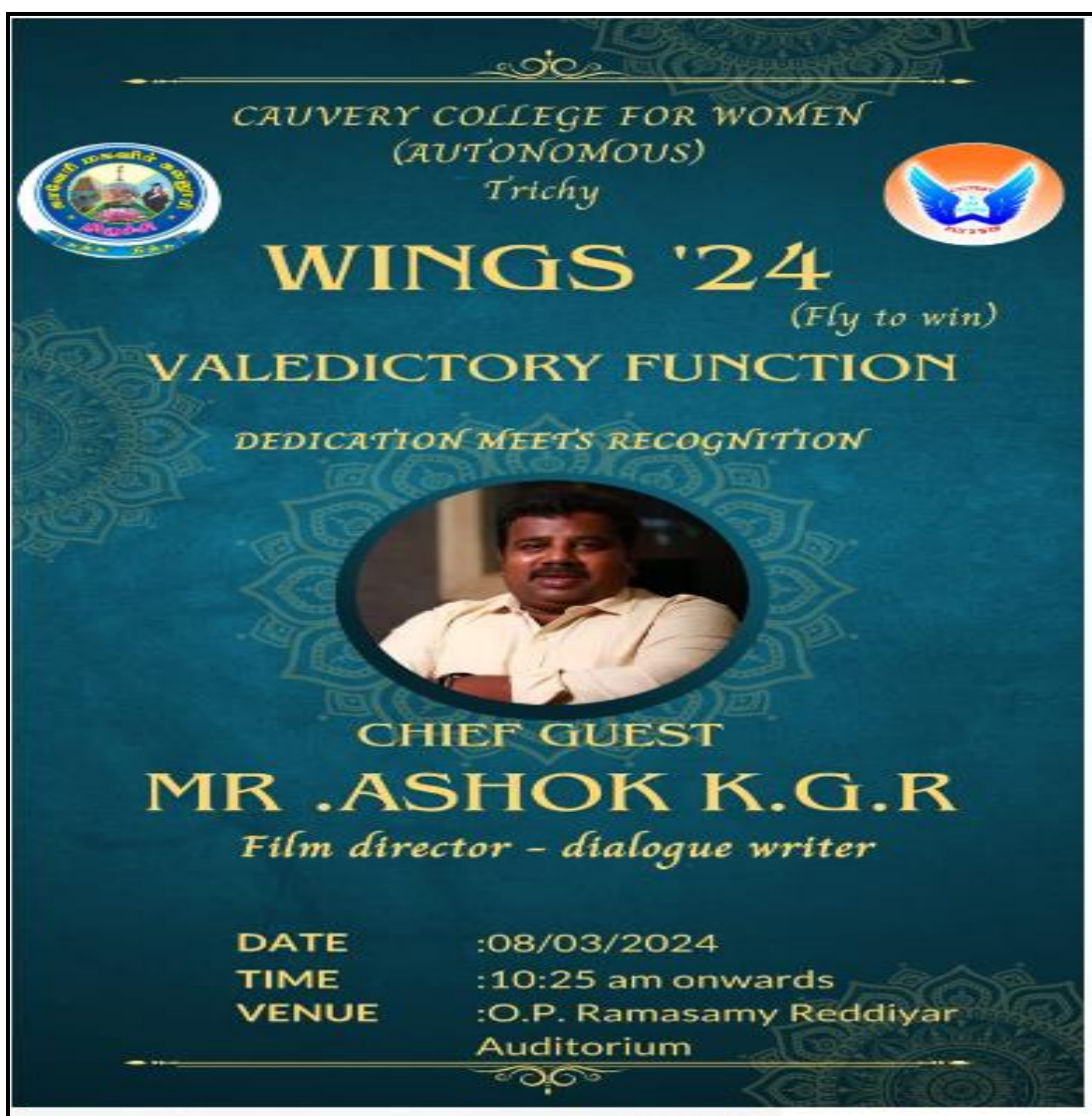

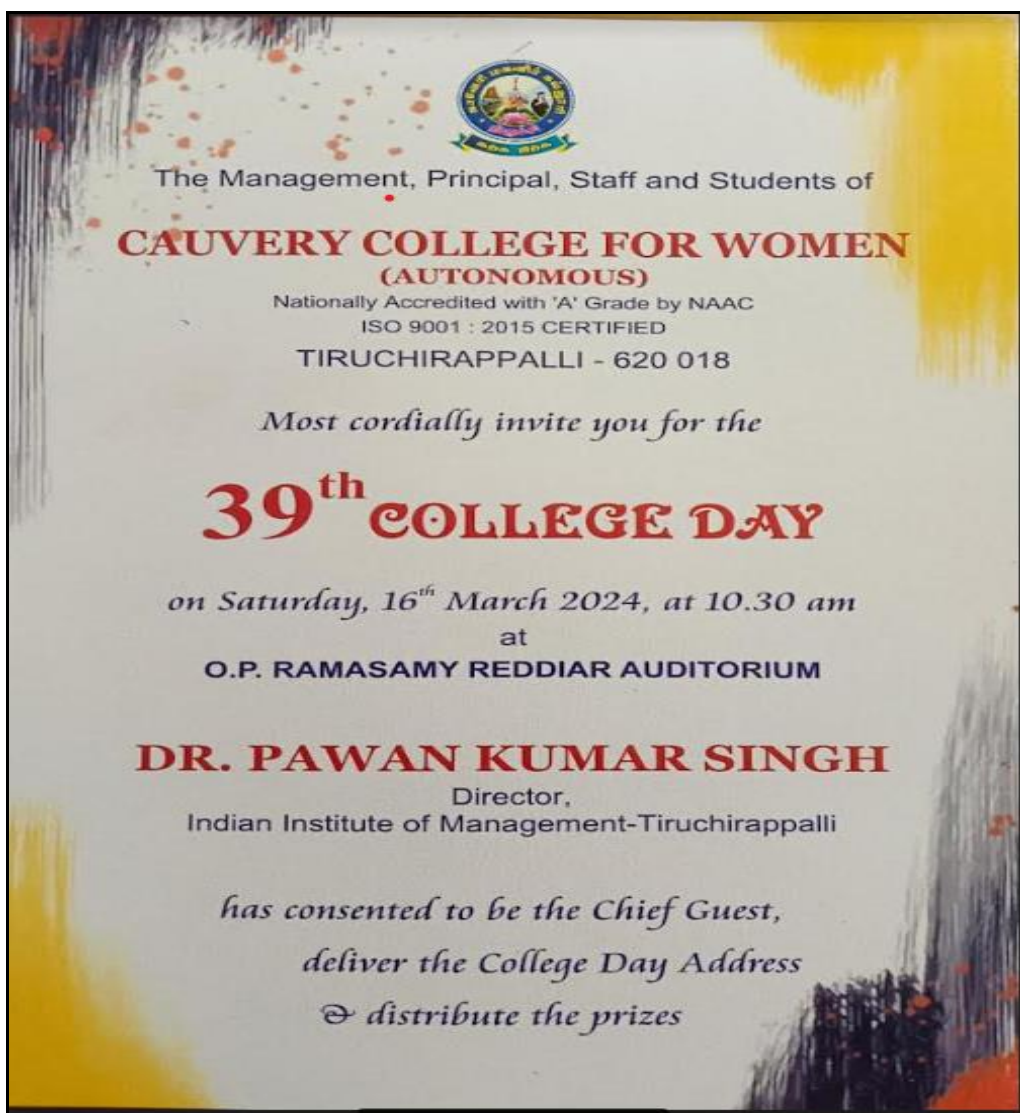

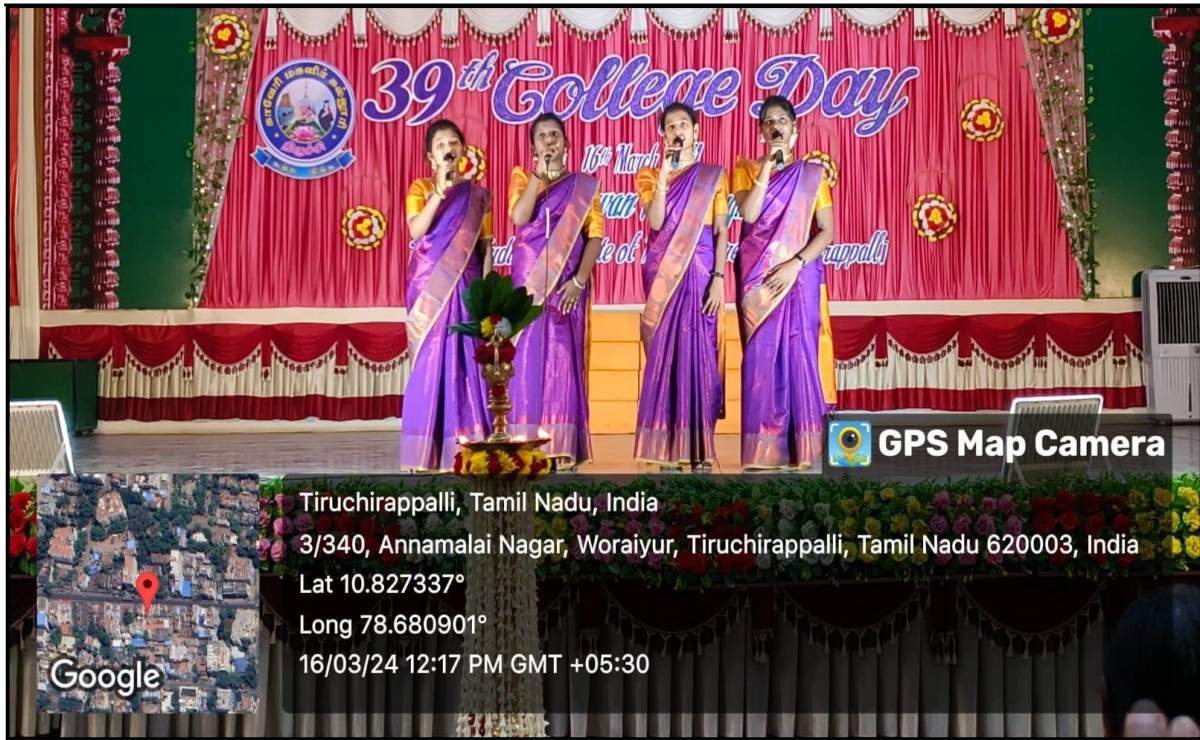
