Institution Scholarship Policy

The Reddy Educational Trust, Tiruchirappalli formed in the year 1984 with 48 members coming from various walks of life have started Cauvery College for Women to promote academic excellence, inculcate qualities of competence, confidence and excellence for employability & self reliant women individuals by imparting higher education to women from local and rural areas.

The Trust is not only focused on providing education but also concerned in extending financial support for academically sound but economically weaker students.

The Trust is granting 50% of semester fees as Freship to 50 UG students and 10 PG students every year. These students are identified and approved by the trust members.

Students who are exemplary in sports and who participate in state and national level competitions are given full fees as scholarships.

This institution has been recognized for developing human capital with technical knowledge, skills, values and attitudes for sustainable economic growth, social development and alleviation of poverty in the society by developing self reliant women students by tapping and nurturing their potentials.

Merit Scholarship Policy

In addition to the existing institution scholarship scheme, the Management of Cauvery College for Women has introduced a Merit cum Means scholarship scheme from the year 2021-2022.

The College has created a Corpus fund with Rs. 1,35,00,000/- for granting scholarship. It is proposed to add Rs.25,00,000/- every year to this corpus. The eligible students are identified on the basis of the criteria such as both parentless, single parentless, economically weak and academically proficient. The selected students will be given a fixed sum as scholarship for five semesters starting from the first semester.

Cauvery College Alumnae Association, Tiruchirappalli plays an imperative role to support the needy, deserving and financially backward students who are pursuing their Undergraduate courses both in Arts and Science streamline. 1 year students should be selected from the following categories to receive financial assistance from CCAA:

- Parentless students
- Single parent students
- Students having sustained higher academic score
- Parents having illness
- Students not having support of Breadwinners
- Having desire to study and to become economically independent
- Children of agricultural coolies and not having regular income

The CCAA Treasurer will issue an application form to the deserving students to have all necessary details such as personal information, academic records of X, XII standards and passport size photo.

Students selected by the class in-charges will be scrutinized by the head of the departments with their profile and application form.

After receiving recommendations from the Head of the Departments, students will be screened and finalized by Madam Principal through an interview. The selected list will be forwarded to the office bearers of CCAA especially to the Treasurer to proceed further.

From the semester fees, only part amount will be paid by CCAA to the selected students in their II, IV and VI semesters.

The selected students of CCAA have to pass in all the subjects. If a student fail in any subject will not receive further financial assistance from CCAA.

Benevolent Alumnae contribution will also be utilized to support the needy, deserving and financially backward students.
