POLICY FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO TEACHING STAFFS

- Travel Allowance is provided to encourage participation in National and International (one way) conferences and workshops.
- For Membership fee in Professional Bodies
- Seed Money Project.
- Publish Books, Book Chapters, Articles indexed in Scopus, Web of Science, UGC care list quartile Journals.

Provision to receive Funds - Department

- To Organize Professional Development Programmes, Conference, Seminars, Capacity Building Programmes, Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs), Management Development Programmes (MDPs) & Career and Skill capability enhancement programmes.

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
